The event raised an estimated \$250,000 to be used by HMSHost Foundation in its mission to fight poverty and strengthen communities.

CORE is an organization that supports children of food and beverage families facing life-altering events such as death, medical conditions, home loss, and other extreme circumstances. In attendance as a featured beneficiary of the unique services provided by CORE was the Adkins family of Bradenton Florida. CORE supported the Adkins family when their baby daughter faced serious health issues.

The HMSHost Foundation Invitational Golf Classic is held annually at the Reunion Resort and Club. This year's tournament, with presenting sponsor AB InBev, drew record attendance with over 325 golfers registered to hit the links and participate in friendly contests in support of HMSHost Foundation's mission.
