



HMSHost Foundation Awards \$15,000 Grant to Feeding Tampa Bay to Expand Community Market Program

Funds Were Raised through Donations to the Foundation Made by Passengers Traveling to and through Tampa International Airport

BETHESDA, Maryland (Aug. 29, 2023) – [HMSHost Foundation](#) announced today that it has awarded a \$15,000 grant to [Feeding Tampa Bay](#), a member of the [Feeding America](#) network of food banks, to support the growth of its community market program in Hillsborough County, Florida, which increases access to nutritious food for a diverse population of individuals and families facing food insecurity.

Funds were raised through the consistent donations of travelers visiting Tampa International Airport (TPA), who deposited change into canisters at quick-service restaurants operated by global restaurateur [HMSHost](#) or rounded up their bill to the next dollar and more when dining at HMSHost's full-service restaurants. The Foundation introduced its "Round Up for Charity" program at TPA earlier this year.
