We look forward to continuing to fight the good fight, together.

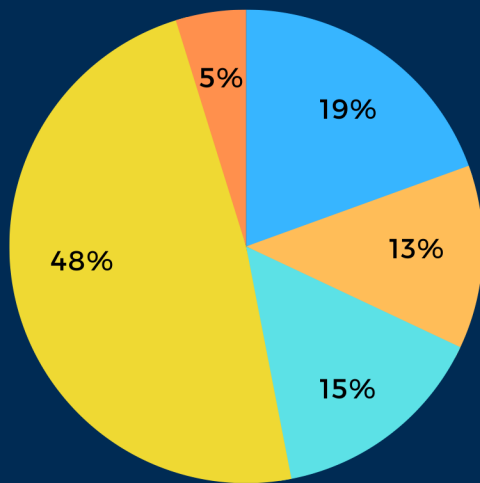

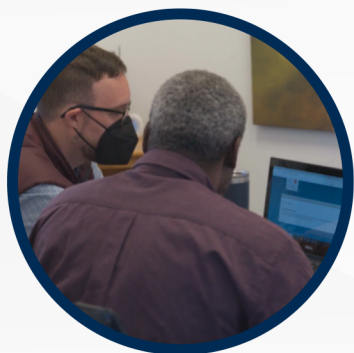
